The Assessment

Professional Communication & Employment Preparation (5 ECTS)

Professional Practice is assessed by way of competencies and is a 100% CA:

CV = 10% (Week 12)

LinkedIn Profile = 10% (Week 12)

Final Portfolio/Presentation (2 minute video) = 40% (Week 12)

Mock Interview = 40% (Week 13)

The Assessment

Professional Practice in Fintech Risk & Compliance (15 ECTS)

Learners will be required to complete all SIX of the CORE competencies = 30%

Learners must complete a minimum of SIX ELECTIVE competencies = 30%

Learners will submit a portfolio summarising their learning experience = 40%

What are the Competencies?

The competencies – core & elective – are mapped to the module's 6 Learning Outcomes

Demonstrate professional judgement in the context of the risk & compliance practices relevant to your chosen financial services provider/employer

Demonstrate practical knowledge and understanding of the Fintech Operating Environment of your chosen financial services provider / employer

Demonstrate an awareness of Regtech / Fintech solutions as applicable to your chosen financial services provider/employer

Demonstrate competence in the application of effective processes required to comply with regulatory requirements as applicable to your chosen financial services provider / employer

Demonstrate an understanding and application of the ethical practices and your personal responsibility

Demonstrate awareness of and commitment to environmentally and socially sustainable practices.

How do I source/reference content for the Competencies?

CORE

Reflective assessment of the current industry and regulatory environment from the perspective of your chosen financial services provider/employer.

ELECTIVE

Reference existing company-specific policies/frameworks & specific industry/regulatory guidance relevant to your chosen financial services provider/employer

What about the Portfolio?

Create a report summarising your learning experience from the professional practice module with specific emphasis on:

- (1) Reflection on transversal skills used in meeting each of the competencies;
- (2) Summary of overall performance / achievements;
- (3) Reflection on Personal Growth and/or areas of improvement.

Your submission should be presented:

- (a) in a report format of your choosing;
- (b) contain a unique title reflecting your journey.

When are the Competencies & Final Portfolio Due?

Core Competencies 1-3 = End Week 6

** Drafts of Core Competency 1 = End Week 3*

Elective Competencies 1-3 = End Week 6

** Drafts of Elective Competency 1 = End Week 3*

Core Competencies 4-6 = End Week 9

Elective Competencies 4-6 = End Week 12

Final Portfolio = End Week 13

What is the role of the Mentor/Employer?

At the commencement of the Module the Mentor/Employer will sign the Mentor/Employer Engagement Form showing they are aware of the topics, demands and timelines of the module.

The Mentor/Employer agrees to attend 3 to 4 meetings with the student over the duration of this module and will confirm by signature that such meetings have taken place.

What is the Cost?

There is no Springboard funding available for this course in 2023

The initial fee for the Certificate – that converts the Diploma into the Bachelor in Business in Fintech Risk & Compliance – is **Euro 990**

Assuming graduates paid a fee of Euro 460 to complete the Diploma this translates into a total cost of **Euro 1,450** for the full Bachelor's award
