In another busy week in the world of Fintech, Risk and Compliance this report really caught my attention:

LinkedIn's 2025 Future of Recruiting Report: Key Findings

The report reveals significant shifts in recruitment strategies that we hope align with PAT Fintech's mission to prepare graduates for the evolving financial technology landscape.

- 73% of talent acquisition professionals agree that AI will fundamentally change how organisations hire
- Al adoption is accelerating while helping recruiters automate routine tasks and focus on strategic activities
- Top benefits of AI in hiring include:
 - Improving hiring efficiency (70%)
 - Boosting job post effectiveness (47%)
 - Expanding talent pools (39%)
 - Enhancing candidate experience (37%)
 - o Increasing quality of hires (33%)

Challenges in AI Implementation

Despite its potential, organisations face hurdles when implementing AI:

- Data privacy/security concerns (37%)
- Budget limitations (36%)
- Accuracy concerns (33%)
- Uncertainty about where to start (32%)
- Legal/compliance issues (31%)

Skills-Based Hiring Gaining Momentum

- 93% of TA professionals believe accurately assessing a candidate's skills is crucial for improving hire quality
- Skills-based hiring addresses talent gaps by prioritising capabilities over degrees or job history
- This approach unlocks untapped talent pools, improves role alignment, and drives quality hires

Quality of Hire Becoming Priority

- 61% of TA pros believe AI can improve how they measure quality of hire
- Organizations are increasingly focused on long-term value over speed
- Al tools provide predictive insights that help measure hiring effectiveness
